# Warning signs to look for:

- Talking about wanting to die or suicide
- Looking for a way to kill themselves
- Lack of care for themselves
- Exhibiting moodiness, tearfulness, or depressed affect
- Anxiety or agitation

- Sudden changes in medications
- Has prescriptions from another pharmacy
- Attempting to fill medications early
- Filling prescriptions for high-risk medications
- No sense of purpose
